IN THIS EXAMPLE: I didn't find a school [that is trying to shift this paradigm] but I did find an article about how little the amount about historical women are taught in schools, and the diversity of the women is also very small, with most of the women being Caucasian. This article shows that there is misogyny in schools.

As of 2017, state and D.C. social studies standards, which set goals for each grade level, obliged K-12 public schools to cover 737 historic figures: 559 men and 178 women (including two fictional characters, Molly Pitcher and Rosie the Riveter. (White, 2019)
